• Saint-Mammès: PK Seine 81.230

• Moret-sur-Loing: PK Loing 47.850

Rail: From Paris Gare de Lyon station, to either Moret/Veneux-Les Sablons (45 min) or Saint-Mammès station (50 min)

Road:

- autoroute A5 : exit Montereau-Fault-Yonne, take D606, then exit Moret-sur-Loing
- from A6 : exit Fontainebleau, take D606, then exit Veneux/Moret-sur-Loing
















PORT SERVICES

Summer season from April through October and winter season from October to March

- multilingual reception
- advance reservations for boats more than 16 meters
- heated sanitary facilities
- inland waterway, technical and tourist information
- documentation

CAPACITIES

> STOPOVER OF SAINT-MAMMÈS

15 bis, quai de Seine – 77670 Saint-Mammès

13 places + 2 places for passenger boats

- maximum draught: 2.40 meters
- water and electricity:
 125 A, 63 A, 32 A and 16 A
- max. length: 70 meters for hotel or residential boats and 15 meters for pleasure craft

> STOPOVER OF MORET-SUR-LOING

77250 Moret-sur-Loing

9 places + 1 place for passenger boat

- max. draught: 1.80 meter and 1.50 meter for pleasure craft
- water and electricity: 32 A and 16 A
- max. length: 40 meters for hotel or residential boats and 15 meters for pleasure craft

> STOPOVER PRUGNAT

Upstream from the Moret-sur-Loing lock

3 places on the Canal du Loing

- max. draught : 1.70 meter
- no water or electricity



SAINT-MAMMÈS

Saint-Mammès is situated at the confluent of the Seine and Loing Rivers 80 kilometers upstream from Paris. The identity of the town was shaped by inland waterway transport, and while that activity is



of lesser economic importance than in the past, it remains present today in the original urban structure and the privileged place of nautical activities.

TO SEE

The church (11th century), the old lock (1724), the lock keeper's house (18th century), the many narrow streets and alleys, the nautical jousts.

TO DO

Weekly sunday market on the banks of the Seine, strolling along the quais, guided tours of the town, the "World of Bargemen" walk, the Barge World Museum (with reservation).



MORET-SUR-LOING

One hour from Paris, at the border between the Île-de-France and Burgundy regions, Moret-sur-Loing is a medieval fortified town from the 12th century preserving within its walls the traces of its glorious history as a royal city with cathedral, castle keep, ramparts and fortified gates. Bathed by the waters of the Loing, Moret is ideal for a pastoral stroll.

TO SEE

The ramparts, the bridge (12th century), the tanbark mill, the Notre-Dame cathedral (12th to 16th centuries), the town hall, the François 1^{er} façade (in the courtyard of the town hall), the Raccolet house, the Burgundy and Samois gates (12th century) and the Priory of Pont Loup (12th century).

TO DO

Point Sisley, the Barley Sugar Museum, the Bicycle Museum, the Municipal Museum, the Art Gallery and during the summer period: outdoor cinema, canoe tours, bicycle tours, hot-air balloon flights and guided tours (with reservation).
